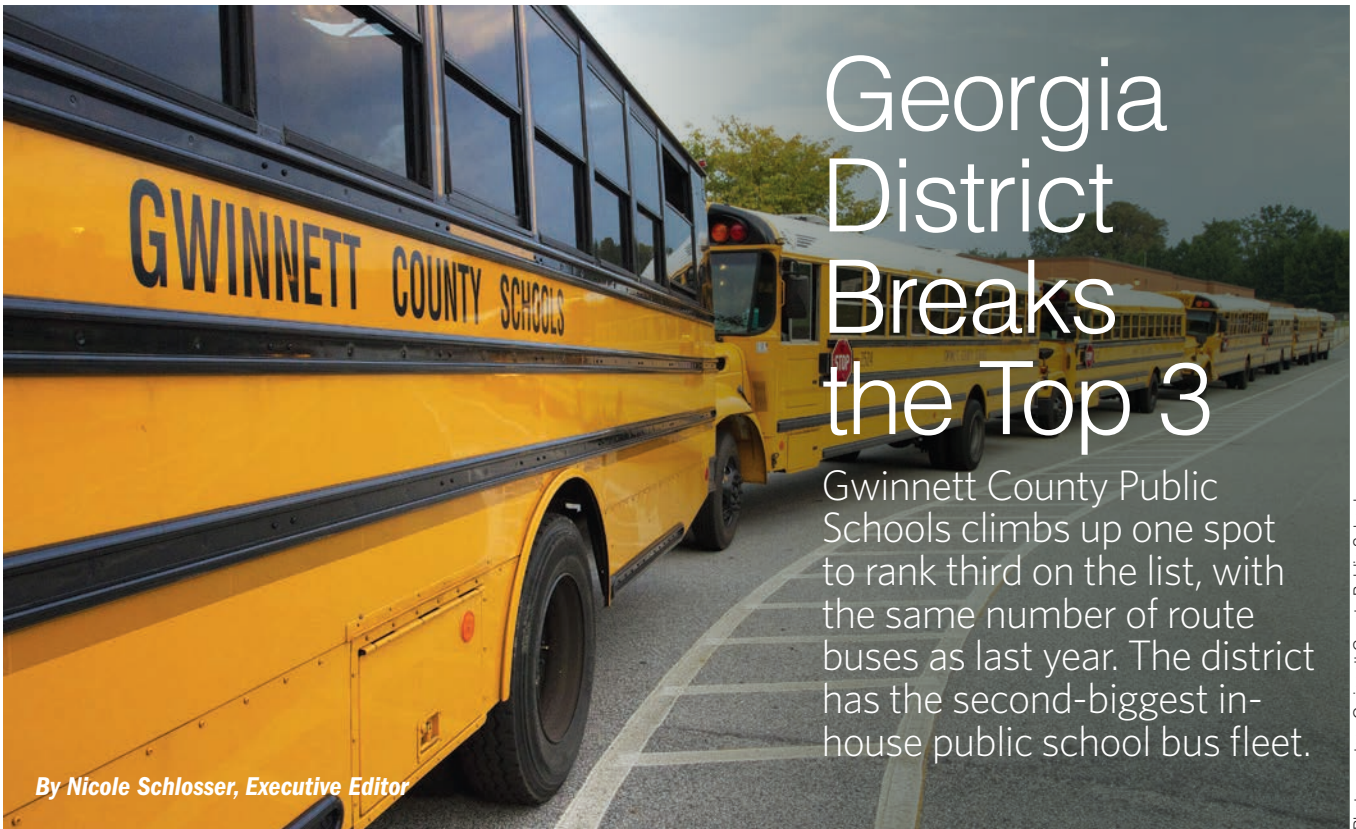

## Georgia District Breaks the Top 3

Gwinnett County Public Schools climbs up one spot to rank third on the list, with the same number of route buses as last year. The district has the second-biggest in-house public school bus fleet.

This year's Top 100 School District Fleets list saw a shift in the top five rankings, along with several new additions.

Gwinnett County (Ga.) Public Schools climbed up one spot, from No. 4 to No. 3, with the same number of route buses as last year — 1,636 — as Los Angeles Unified School District reported 304 fewer route buses than last year and dropped two spots from No. 2 to No. 4. (The Top 100 is ranked by number of route buses.) Gwinnett County has the second-biggest in-house public school bus fleet among the district fleets represented on the list. Los Angeles USD has a combined district and contractor operation.

This year, Clark County School District in Las Vegas comes in at No. 2, but remains the biggest publicly owned and operated school bus fleet in the U.S. None of the district's route buses are operated by contractors.

The New York City Department of Education continues to hold the top spot on the Top 100 with 8,215 route buses. It is entirely serviced by contractors.

For this year's list, we identified several other school districts that have fleets large enough to be ranked in the Top 100 but weren't previously. Those are:

- Rockford (Ill.) Public Schools District 205, coming in at No. 71 with 265 route buses.
- Carroll County Public Schools in Westminster, Md., entering at No. 72 with 260 route buses.
- Stafford County Public Schools in Fredericksburg, Va., joining the list at No. 76 with 250 route buses.
- Klein (Texas) Independent School District, coming in at No. 82 with 245 route buses.
- La Joya (Texas) Independent School District, taking spot No. 89 with 220 route buses.
- St. Mary's Public Schools in Leonardtown, Md., entering at No. 96 with 202 route buses.
- El Paso (Texas) Independent School District, joining at No. 99 with 199 route buses.

Should your district be on the list? If you have about 150 or more school buses in route service (including any that are operated by contractors), you should be in the running for the Top 100.

Once again this year, New York City's 8,215 route buses, all operated by contractors, transport the biggest ridership of any school district in the nation. Fairfax (Va.) County Public Schools comes in a close second, transporting 141,880 students daily with 1,181 route buses.
