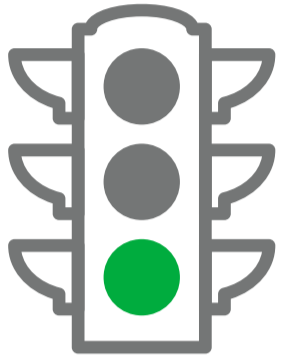


# The state of driving safety for commercial vehicles in the U.S.

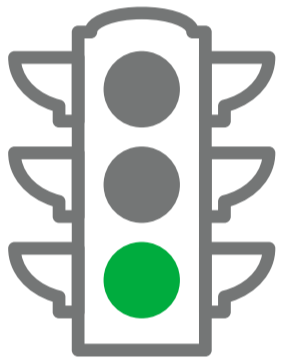

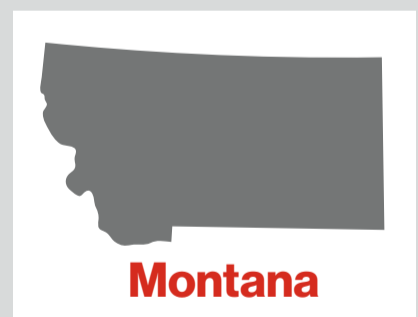
